

 Schedule of fees and charges

Following is the current schedule of fees which can be paid by credit card (preferred method), cheque, money order, EFTPOS or cash. Do not send cash by mail.

ALL fees MUST be paid in Australian dollars (\$AUD)

Acceptable forms of payment:

➤ **Credit card (e.g. Visa, Mastercard or American Express) is the preferred method of payment**

- Bank draft
- Cheque
- International money order
- Australian money order
- Cash – **at office counter only**, do not mail
- Eftpos – **at office counter only**, not available through mail or by phone.

Please note:

- Council will not accept any international personal cheques or traveller's cheques.
- International bank drafts or cheques must be payable to an Australian bank.

If you are paying by credit card, you must authorise the amount to be deducted from your account by writing the amount on your application form at item 12..

Application fee \$49.00

An application fee is required for all the following applications:

- Registration
- Enrolment
- Authorisation to practise midwifery
- Endorsement
- Restoration*
- Duplicate certificate
- Replacement of badge
- Replacement of licence

***Restoration applicants**

- If you are applying for restoration and have not practised nursing or midwifery within the last five (5) years, please initially, only pay the restoration application fee.
- You will be advised in writing when to pay the licence fee and the applicable amount at that time.

Overseas assessment charge \$109.00

An overseas assessment fee is required, in addition to the application fee, for all applicants applying to Queensland Nursing Council for the first time, who have gained their qualifications overseas.

Overseas qualified applicants

- All overseas qualified applicants, from countries **other than** United Kingdom, Ireland, New Zealand, Canada, and USA (who are not applying under mutual recognition), are requested to initially pay only the application fee and overseas assessment charge.
- You will be advised in writing when to pay the licence fee and the applicable amount at that time.
- **Credit card is the preferred payment method.**

Licence fee \$94.00

A licence fee is required, in addition to the application fee (and overseas assessment charge, where applicable) for the following applications:

- Registration
- Enrolment
- Authorisation to practise midwifery
- Restoration*

Verification fee \$62.00

A verification (letter of good standing) to other regulatory authorities.

Annual licence renewal fee \$94.00

All licence certificates expire on the 30 June each year. Nurses and midwives must renew their licence between 1 April and 30 June each year, to enable practice for the next twelve (12) months, and pay the annual licence fee.
